THE MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

The Kemptville Youth Centre Membership and Rewards program, is a new initiative aimed to increase attendance and volunteering at Youth Centre events while providing benefits to those Youth who choose to participate. Although not a general requirement for Youth to come to the centre, membership is a requirement in order for Youth to receive and redeem reward points, as well as to enjoy the many program benefits. .

At a cost of \$30.00, the KYC Membership Package includes the following items:

- A Laminated Photo Membership Card (Valid for one year)
- A Kemptville Youth Centre T-shirt
- A Kemptville Youth Centre Lanyard

In addition to this merchandise, membership also includes the following benefits for 2012:

- Free entry to any events held on Kemptville Youth Centre premises.
- 10% off trips hosted by the Kemptville Youth Centre but held at other locations.
- Special pricing on canteen items for the months of January, June and December
- Entry into the Kemptville Youth Centre Rewards program
- Double reward points for the months of February, March and April



THE REWARDS PROGRAM

Although there are many other benefits to joining the program, probably the best benefit of membership with the Kemptville Youth Centre, is entry into the rewards program. This program awards points for both participation in Youth Centre programs as well as Volunteering with KYC. The following is a breakdown of how points are awarded to a participant; as well as how and when points can be redeemed:

Awarding

- One (1) point is awarded for every regularly scheduled weekly program attended (i.e. RBC Afterschool, Sports Night, etc.).
- Ten (10) points are awarded for every one (1) hour of volunteering on behalf of the Youth Centre. This would include volunteering for Youth Centre events OR volunteering for events which the Youth Centre has been requested to supply volunteers (i.e. Christmas Hampers with the Salvation Army). These hours can also be applied to the 40 hours required to graduate high school.
- Thirty (30), to a maximum of ninety (90), points are awarded to a youth for every new member who they are directly responsible for recruiting. These points will only be given if, at the time of membership registration, the recommending youth is present with the new member

Redemption

- One hundred (100) points can be redeemed in exchange for \$5.00 off of any KYC trip or event. This discount, however; cannot be combined with the 10% off benefit included with membership.
- In addition to redeemable points, every month members will be able to enter a draw to win a prize purchased from a local Kemptville business. In order to be eligible for the draw, a youth need only have (at least) 25 points remaining in their account.
- Points are not lost at the end of a month, and instead carry over each until the end of the year, However, after points had been redeemed once, they cannot be used again.
